Over the past month, the San Diego Police Department has investigated several armed robberies associated with parties and people walking in the College Area. Due to the ongoing series, law enforcement is concerned for students and people in the San Diego State University area.

As a result, the San Diego State University Police Department encourages all members of the SDSU Community to remain alert and aware of your surroundings. Please remember to keep your belongings secure. We recommend that you do not let strangers into your home, and travel in groups with people you trust. Also, we ask that you refrain from using your cellphone while walking. If you choose to consume intoxicating substances, please do so responsibly and in moderation. Report all suspicious activity and dial 911.

While on campus, there are over 170 emergency blue light phones which will connect you directly with the San Diego State University Police Department. Download the Aztec Shield mobile safety app to connect with SDSU Police and request safety escorts on campus.
