Lt. Gilbert coordinated the Annual Spring (partial) Campus Evacuation Drill, which included the following buildings:

Adams Humanities, Administration, Alumni Center, Aztec Athletic Center, Calpulli, Faculty Staff Club, Hardy Tower, Hepner Hall, Life Sciences North, Little Theatre, Peterson Gym. All buildings were evacuated within the 5 minutes goal, with no significant incidents to report.

Police Recruit Greg Small started the police academy (968 hours) at the San Diego Regional Public Safety Training Institute, and is scheduled to graduate on Oct. 11, 2007.

Lt. Gilbert coordinate the following meetings: Campus' Enrollment Services to provide our Department with access to the University's on-line ASTRA meeting and classroom scheduling software for emergency planning and response. Campus' Instructional Technical Services to develop a University's emergency notification system utilizing the campus' Closed Circuit Television System (CCTV) for emergency planning and response.
