



Timely Warning Crime Bulletin

- Armed Robbery-

This Timely Warning Bulletin is being issued in compliance with the Jeanne Clery Act. The purpose is to provide preventative information to the campus community to aid members from becoming the victim of a crime.

Incident: Armed Robbery

Location: 5100 Block of College Avenue, at the Eureka! Restaurant

Date/Time: 10/04/22, 7:46 p.m.

Warning issued: 10/04/22, 11:30 p.m.

Summary: University Police are actively searching for an armed suspect who robbed an individual seated at the Eureka! restaurant patio. The incident was reported to have occurred tonight, at about 7:46 p.m. The suspect pointed a gun at the individual's chest, demanded their backpack and then fled the area with the backpack. The victim did not sustain any injuries and no shots were fired.

Suspect: The victim described the suspect as a 5' 4" male adult with a medium build, wearing black pants and a black hooded sweatshirt with the hood over his head.

The San Diego State University Police Department (UPD) is investigating this incident as Case #22-1170
